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Introduction

Many people assume science has eliminated the need for God.

Surprisingly, some of the greatest scientific discoveries of the last century have done the opposite. Rather than removing God from the conversation, they have raised profound questions about the origin of the universe, life, and humanity itself. Science is excellent at explaining how things work.

But some of the biggest questions remain:

- Why does anything exist?
- Why is the universe so orderly?
- Where did life come from?
- Where did information **come** from?
- Why are humans conscious and moral beings?

Let's examine five discoveries that continue to challenge scientists and philosophers alike.

1. THE UNIVERSE HAD A BEGINNING

For centuries many scientists believed the universe was eternal.

Then came one of the greatest discoveries in scientific history:

The universe is expanding.

This led to what is commonly called the Big Bang

theory.

Ironically, the Big Bang does not explain where everything came from.

It points to a beginning.

If the universe had a beginning, what caused it?

Genesis 1:1

"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."

2. THE UNIVERSE IS FINELY TUNED FOR LIFE

Scientists have discovered that numerous physical constants appear precisely calibrated for life.

Examples include:

- Gravity
- Electromagnetism
- The strong nuclear force
- The expansion rate of the universe

If these values were altered even slightly, life could not exist.

Our own planet also appears remarkably suited for life.

The Earth orbits the sun at just the right distance to support liquid water and a stable climate.

If Earth were significantly closer to the sun, temperatures could become too hot for life as we know it.

If Earth were significantly farther away, the planet could become too cold.

Scientists often refer to this region as the "habitable zone" or the "Goldilocks zone"—not

too hot and not too cold.

In addition, Earth's orbit is nearly circular. If it were much more elliptical, extreme temperature swings could make life difficult or impossible. Earth's atmosphere, magnetic field, rotation rate, and many other factors also contribute to making life possible.

The question becomes:

Why is the universe so perfectly suited for life?

Accident?

Necessity?

Or design?

3. DNA CONTAINS INFORMATION

One of the most remarkable discoveries of modern science is DNA.

Inside every living cell is a digital code containing instructions for life.

DNA is not merely chemistry.

It is information.

Information is normally associated with intelligence.

Books come from authors.

Computer code comes from programmers.

Instructions come from minds.

Scientists estimate that the DNA inside a single human cell contains approximately 3 billion genetic letters.

If that information were printed in ordinary books, it would fill roughly 1,000 to 2,000 volumes of about 500 pages each.

Yet all of that information is stored within a microscopic cell invisible to the naked eye.

The question is not merely how DNA works.

The question is:

Where did the information come from?

Everywhere we observe complex information in daily life, we find an intelligent source behind it.

Libraries require authors.

Computer programs require programmers.

Instruction manuals require designers.

DNA contains vastly more information than any computer program ever written.

The more scientists learn about DNA, the more they discover an astonishing system of information, storage, replication, and error correction operating within every living cell.

Where did the information in DNA originate?

Romans 1:20

"For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen..."

4. LIFE APPEARS EXTRAORDINARILY COMPLEX

Even the simplest living cell contains:

Scientists have learned much about life.

Yet the origin of the first living cell remains one of science's greatest mysteries.

Life comes from life.

But where did the first life originate?

John 1:3-4

"All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life..."

A Surprise Discovery

Many scientists once assumed that the simplest living organisms would eventually be shown to be relatively simple machines.

As microscopes improved and scientific knowledge increased, many expected life's mysteries to disappear.

Instead, the opposite happened.

The more scientists discovered, the more complexity they found.

What once appeared to be a simple cell is now known to contain:

- Molecular machines
- Information storage systems
- Error-correction mechanisms
- Energy production systems
- Communication networks
- Highly coordinated manufacturing processes

A modern cell has often been compared to a microscopic city filled with factories, transportation systems, power plants, and information centers.

Rather than revealing simplicity, scientific discovery has continually revealed deeper levels of complexity.

The question remains:

How did such an intricate system originate?

The simplest forms of life are far more complex than scientists imagined only a few generations ago.

5. HUMAN CONSCIOUSNESS REMAINS A MYSTERY

Humans are different.

We are self-aware.

We reason.

We create.

We love.

We worship.

We ask questions about our own existence.

Science can study the brain.

But consciousness itself remains one of the greatest unsolved mysteries.
