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WHY SHOULD I BELIEVE?

Introduction

A young man who had grown up in church once made a startling statement:

"I'm only a Christian because I was born into a Christian family."

His words were honest.

Had he been born in India, he might have been Hindu.

Had he been born in Saudi Arabia, he might have been Muslim.

Had he been born in a secular home, he might have become an atheist.

His statement raises an important question:

Are our beliefs simply the result of where we were born?

Or are there genuine reasons to believe in God?

Every person eventually reaches a point where borrowed faith is no longer enough.

Parents can believe for themselves.

Pastors can believe for themselves.

Churches can believe for themselves.

But eventually each person must answer:

Why do I believe?

God never intended faith to be blind, irrational, or based solely upon tradition.

The Bible repeatedly presents evidence, testimony, fulfilled prophecy, personal experience, and eye-witness accounts as reasons for faith.

Christianity invites examination.

Truth has nothing to fear from investigation.

1. EVERYONE HAS FAITH IN SOMETHING

Many people claim they have no faith.

Yet everyone exercises faith every day.

We trust:

- Airplanes we did not build
- Medicines we did not create
- Bridges we did not inspect
- Information we cannot personally verify

Life itself requires faith.

The real question is not:

"Do I have faith?"

The real question is:

"What is my faith placed in?"

Hebrews 11:1

"Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen."

Biblical faith is not wishful thinking.

It is confidence based upon evidence.

2. THE UNIVERSE POINTS TO A CREATOR

When we see a building, we assume a builder.

When we see a painting, we assume a painter.

When we see a design, we assume a designer.

Yet some suggest that the most complex thing ever discovered—the universe—has no designer.

The Bible teaches otherwise.

Psalms 19:1

"The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork."

Creation itself points beyond itself.
Order suggests intelligence.
Design suggests purpose.
The existence of a creation suggests a Creator.

3. THE HUMAN HEART TESTIFIES OF GOD

Throughout history nearly every civilization has believed in some form of higher power.

Why?

Because mankind possesses an awareness that there is something beyond this world.

Ecclesiastes 3:11

*"He hath made every thing beautiful in his time:
also he hath set the world in their heart..."*

God has placed eternity in the human heart.

People search for meaning because they were created for something greater than themselves.

4. JESUS CHANGED HISTORY

Whether one believes in Him or not, few would deny the impact of Jesus Christ.

History itself was changed by His life.

His teachings transformed nations.

His followers willingly suffered persecution rather than deny what they had seen.

The question is not whether Jesus existed.

The question is:

Who was He?

A good man?

A prophet?
Or exactly who He claimed to be?

5. THE RESURRECTION DEMANDS AN EXPLANATION

Christianity rises or falls on one event:

The resurrection of Jesus Christ.

If Jesus remained in the grave, Christianity is false.

If He rose again, everything changes.

1 Corinthians 15:14

"And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain."

The apostles did not die for a philosophy.

They testified that they had seen the risen Christ.

Something transformed frightened disciples into fearless witnesses.

The resurrection best explains that change.

6. CHRISTIANITY IS MORE THAN INFORMATION

Christianity is not merely a collection of facts.

It is an invitation to know God personally.

Millions of believers throughout history have testified that God changed their lives.

Broken lives restored.

Addictions conquered.

Hope discovered.

Sins forgiven.

Faith is not merely believing that God exists.

Faith is trusting Him enough to respond.

Jeremiah 29:13

"And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart."

BORROWED FAITH OR PERSONAL FAITH?

At some point every person must move beyond borrowed faith.

You cannot be saved because your parents believe.

You cannot be saved because your pastor believes.

You cannot be saved because your church believes.

You must become convinced for yourself.

John 4:42

"Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ..."

The people of Samaria began by believing another person's testimony.

Eventually they encountered Christ for themselves.

That is God's desire for every person.

Conclusion

God never asks us to believe without reason.

He has provided:

- The witness of creation
- The witness of conscience
- The witness of Scripture

- The witness of prophecy
- The witness of Christ
- The witness of transformed lives

The evidence points toward Him.

The invitation remains open.

The question is no longer:

"Why should I believe?"

The question becomes:

"What will I do with the evidence God has already provided?"

Hebrews 11:6

*"But without faith it is impossible to please him:
for he that cometh to God must believe that he
is..."*
